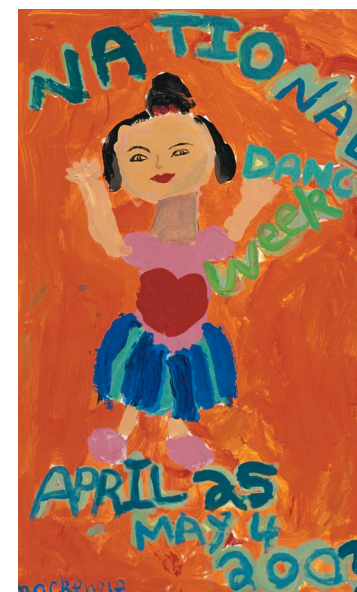


# National Dance Week Poster Contest!

Sponsored by **DANCE MAGAZINE** and **Capezio/Ballet Makers®**, Inc., the annual poster contest supports the mission of National Dance Week: To heighten awareness of dance and its contributions to our culture. Dance is good for the body, mind, and spirit. Cash prizes and certificates will be awarded to the first-, second-, and third-place winners in three age categories. Honorable Mention certificates and gift merchandise may be awarded for special achievement.

## Rules:

- Only one entry per student.
- Entries must contain the following information on the front: the phrase "National Dance Week," the dates April 23 to May 2, and "2004".
- Entries must contain the following information on the back (clearly legible): name, address, telephone number, birth date of contestant, and name and address of current dance teacher and school (if applicable).
- Posters must be at least 5 x 7 inches and no larger than 17 x 22 inches.
- Do not include copies of copyrighted images or characters such as those found in catalogs, magazines, or cartoons. Three-dimensional designs are acceptable.
- Posters will be judged in age-appropriate categories for creativity, effectiveness, and compliance with rules of the contest. Winners will be notified in early March 2004.
- Contestants should fall into one of the three age categories: 6 to 10, 11 to 13, or 14 to 18.
